## Minor Requirements

Students should choose one advisor from the "Advisory Committee" list. To fulfill the minor students must take from this list, a minimum of 18 credit hours. One of these courses must be INTD 21100 SEMINAR IN ASIAN STUDIES/UCS 30301 URGENT CHALLENGE SEMINAR:TT:SEMINAR IN ASIAN STUDIES (4 hours). For breadth, at least one course must be from the history course list, and at least one course must be from the political science course list. Study abroad and language coursework are encouraged but not required. Possible study abroad destinations include India, China, and Japan.
