### One Advanced Research and Writing Courses (1 hour)

Students must take one 1-credit advanced research and writing course as a supplementary course to one of the 3- or 4-credit English courses of their choice other than ENGL 10600 TELLING STORIES:READING LIT:IM.

ENGL 4XXXX Advanced Research and Writing (1 hour)

In this course, students will gain more in-depth knowledge of the topic of the connected course by engaging with extensive secondary materials. They will practice information literacy through original research on their

chosen topic. They will develop their interpretive and close reading skills through the completion of a substantial (12-15 pages) analytical essay. This course may be repeated for credit.
