PROGRAM/MAJOR AND GRADUATION HONORS

Program Honors

Graduating seniors may receive program/major honors if they meet the following criteria:

- An overall grade-point average of at least 2.80 and
- · A major/program grade-point average of at least 3.60 and
- A sum of grade-point averages (overall + major/program) which equals 6.80
- Further requirements for program honors such as papers, examinations, performances, or productions. These will be determined by each program/major conferring the honors.

In addition, the student must be recommended by the program for these honors.

Graduation with Latin Honors

Students may graduate *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, and *summa cum laude* from Hiram College. Students who receive one of these honors are judged on the basis of cumulative grade-point average.

The minimum grade-point requirements are 3.50 for *cum laude*, 3.70 for *magna cum laude*, and 3.90 for *summa cum laude*.

Summa cum laude will be awarded only on the basis of an academic record with no more than three Pass/No Credit courses for a total of 12 semester hours, elected by the student. Summa cum laude will be awarded to transfer students only on the basis of no more than two Pass/No Credit grades elected by the student under the Pass/No Credit option.
